**SPECIAL MINUTES**


The Special Meeting of the Bristow City Council was called to order in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 6:00 P.M. A roll call was had with the following members present. Mayor Rick Pinson. Council members: Joe Church, Brandon Flood, Judd Johns, Tex Slyman, Jeff Willeford and Randy Witty. Absent: Councilmen Jeff Roberts and Kris Wyatt.

Presentation from Jon Wolff and other representatives of Municipal Finance Services, Inc., regarding the finances of the City of Bristow, the Bristow Municipal Authority, the Bristow Hospital Authority, including, but not limited to revenues, expenditures, and budgets for the current and upcoming fiscal year, and including recommendations and related discussion.

Mr. Wolff presented to the council a Financial analysis of the City of Bristow. The City has been breaking even yearly, but not gaining. His recommendation is to look at Sales Tax, Water-Sewer Rates and Obligation Bonds. He suggested the council develop a plan of what their most important priorities are.
