

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

**CDBG-EDIF**

The City of Bristow is considering applying to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce's Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development Infrastructure Financing Program (CDBG-EDIF) for funding assistance. The State of Oklahoma has funds available to units of local government to undertake viable economic development activities that primarily benefit persons defined as low and moderate income.

Economic development has been identified as a community priority need and a tentative decision has been made to seek funding from the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for approximately \$500,000 to extend the City's water and wastewater utility system to the Jones Memorial Airport to support two new industries relocating and/or expanding operations at the airport. Consolidated Turbine Specialists and Timco intend to construct new facilities at the airport.


According to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce's income guidelines, the project will benefit as least 51% of low and moderate income residents.

The purpose of this public hearing is to enable comments on the specific project activities that are proposed and to provide a clear explanation of the probable impacts on the community and residents should the project be funded.

Specific details regarding eligible activities and program requirements will be provided at a public hearing which will be held at 7:00 P.M. on April 6, 2015 at the City Council Meeting Room located at 110 W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Bristow, Oklahoma.
